

## Immunization Requirements 2018-2019 School Year – Reference Guide

### 3 Year olds and 4 Year olds (PRE K)

4 doses of DTP, DTaP, DT

3 doses of Polio

1 dose of MMR on/after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday

1 dose of HIB on/after 15 months OR 3 doses with the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose given on/after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday, and at least 2 months since dose #2

1 dose of \*PCV7 on/after 24 months of age OR 4 doses of PCV7 with one given on first birthday

3 doses of Hepatitis B

1 dose of Varicella on/after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday (if the child has NOT had the chickenpox)

2 doses of Hepatitis A on/after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday (must allow 6-18 month between doses)

◊ HIB and PCV7 not routinely administered to children  $\geq$  5 years of age

### Kindergarten – 6<sup>th</sup> Grade

5 doses of DTP, DTaP, DT with one on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday OR 4 doses if one dose is on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday or if 7 years or older 3 doses acceptable if 1 dose is on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday

4 doses of Polio with one on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday OR 3 doses if one dose is on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday

2 doses of MMR (1 dose can be Measles only if born before 2009) on/after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday

3 doses of Hepatitis B

2 doses of Varicella on/after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday (if the child has not had chickenpox)

2 doses of Hepatitis A on/after first birthday (must allow 6-18 months between doses)

◊ Ages 7 years and older, 3 doses of tetanus containing vaccine

### 7<sup>th</sup> Grade

3 doses of DTP or DTaP and 1 dose of Tdap/Td booster within last 5 years

4 doses of Polio with one on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday OR 3 doses if one dose is on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday

2 doses of MMR, (1 dose can be Measles only if born before 2009) on/after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday

3 doses of Hepatitis B

2 doses of Varicella on/after 1<sup>st</sup> (if the child has not had chickenpox)

2 doses of Hepatitis A on/after first birthday (must allow 6-18 months between doses)

1 dose of Meningococcal (Quadrivalent – Menactra or Menveo)

### 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> Grade

3 doses of DTP or DTaP and 1 dose of Tdap/Td booster within last 10 years

4 doses of Polio with one on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday OR 3 doses if one dose is on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday

2 doses of MMR, (1 dose can be Measles only if born before 2009) on/after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday

3 doses of Hepatitis B

2 doses of Varicella on/after 1<sup>st</sup> (if the child has not had chickenpox)

2 doses of Hepatitis A

1 dose of Meningococcal (Quadrivalent – Menactra or Menveo)

### 10<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> Grade

3 doses of DTP, DTaP, DT, Td, Tdap with one on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday, one dose of Tdap is required within the last 10 years. Td is acceptable in lieu of Tdap if a contraindication to pertussis exists.

4 doses of Polio with one on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday OR 3 doses if one dose is on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday

2 doses of MMR, (1 dose can be Measles only if born before 2009) on/after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday

3 doses of Hepatitis B

2 doses of Varicella on/after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday (if the child has not had chickenpox)

1 dose of Meningococcal (Quadrivalent – Menactra or Menveo)
