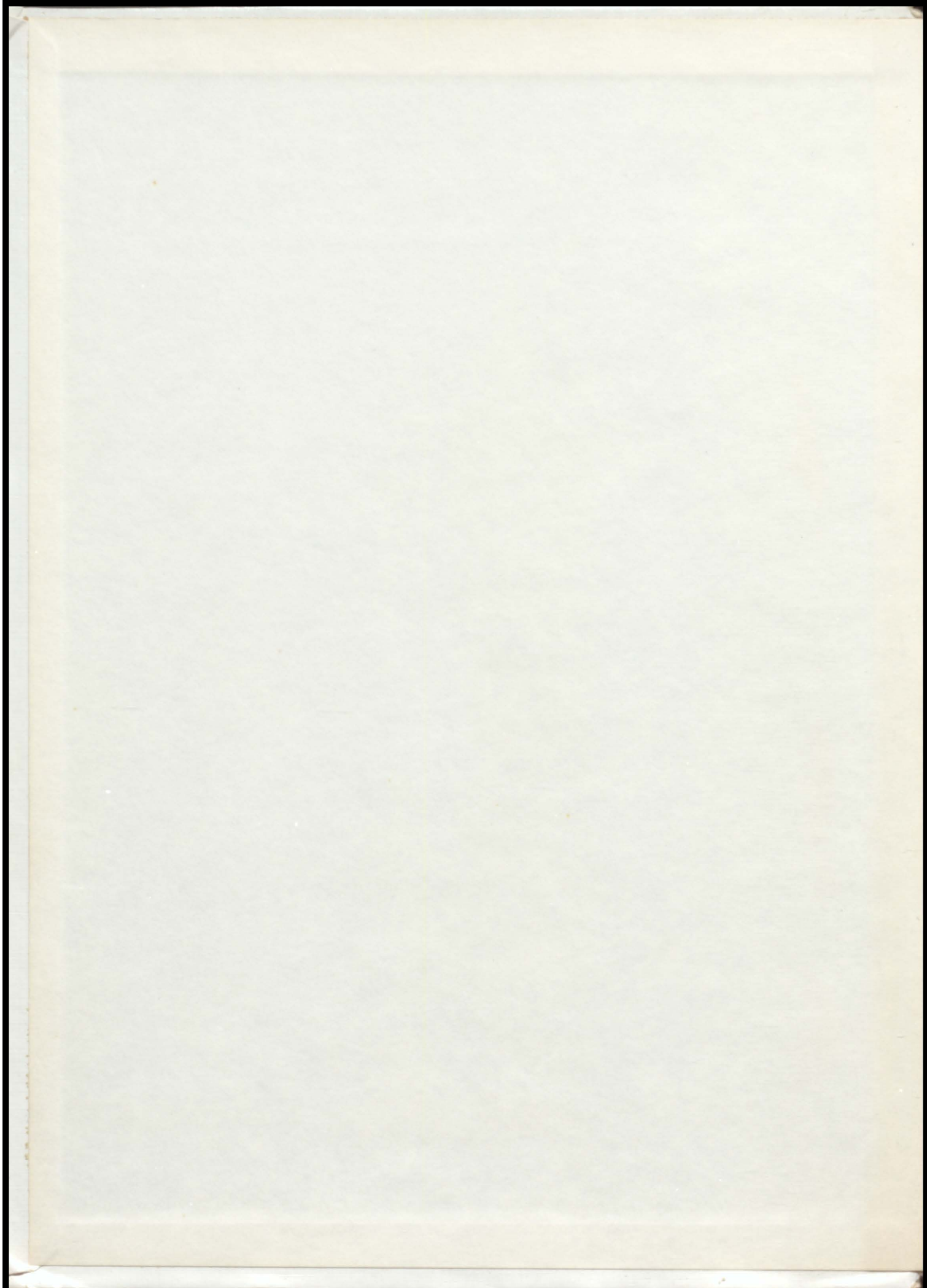
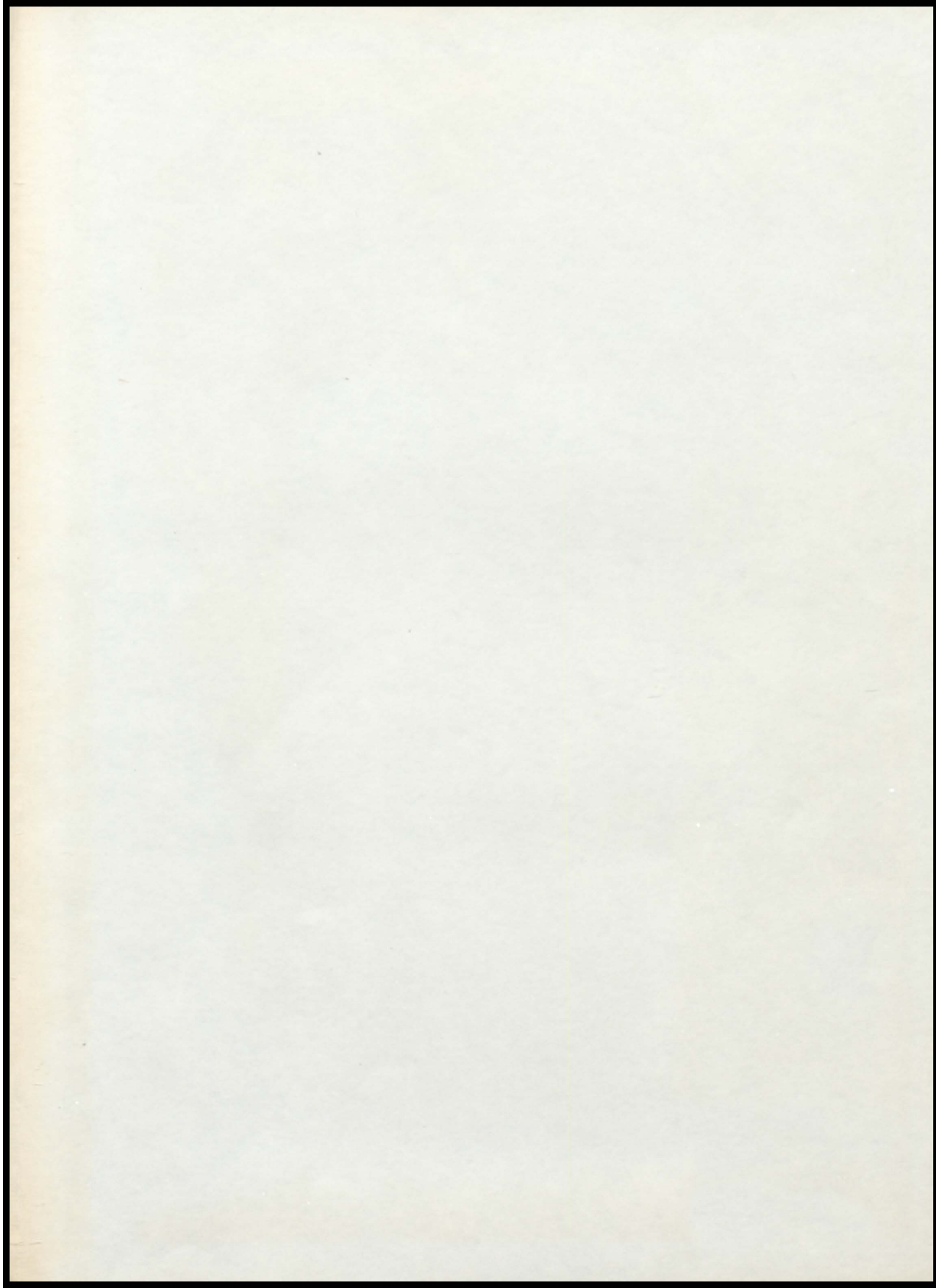
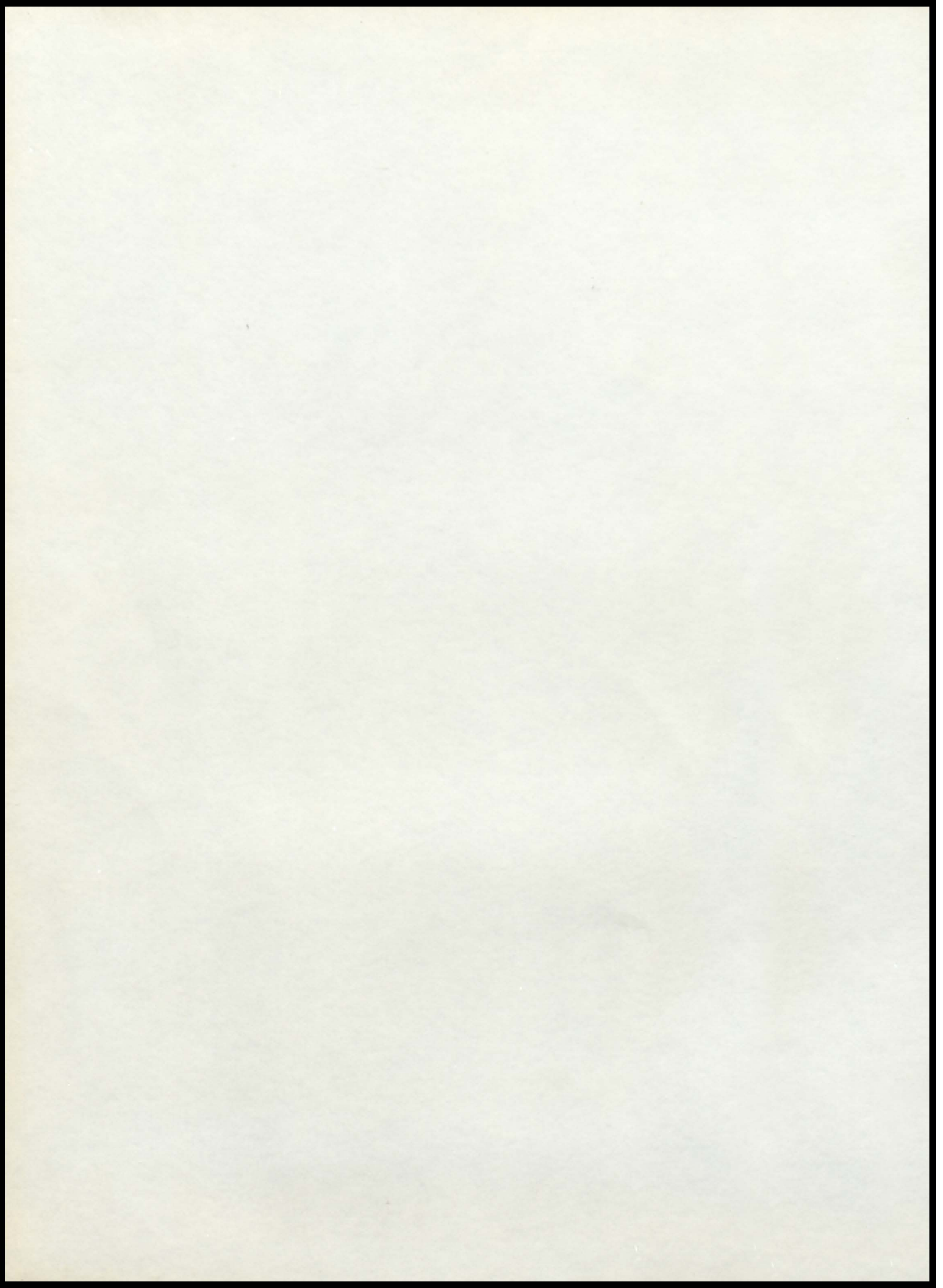

 Fruitvale High will make history.

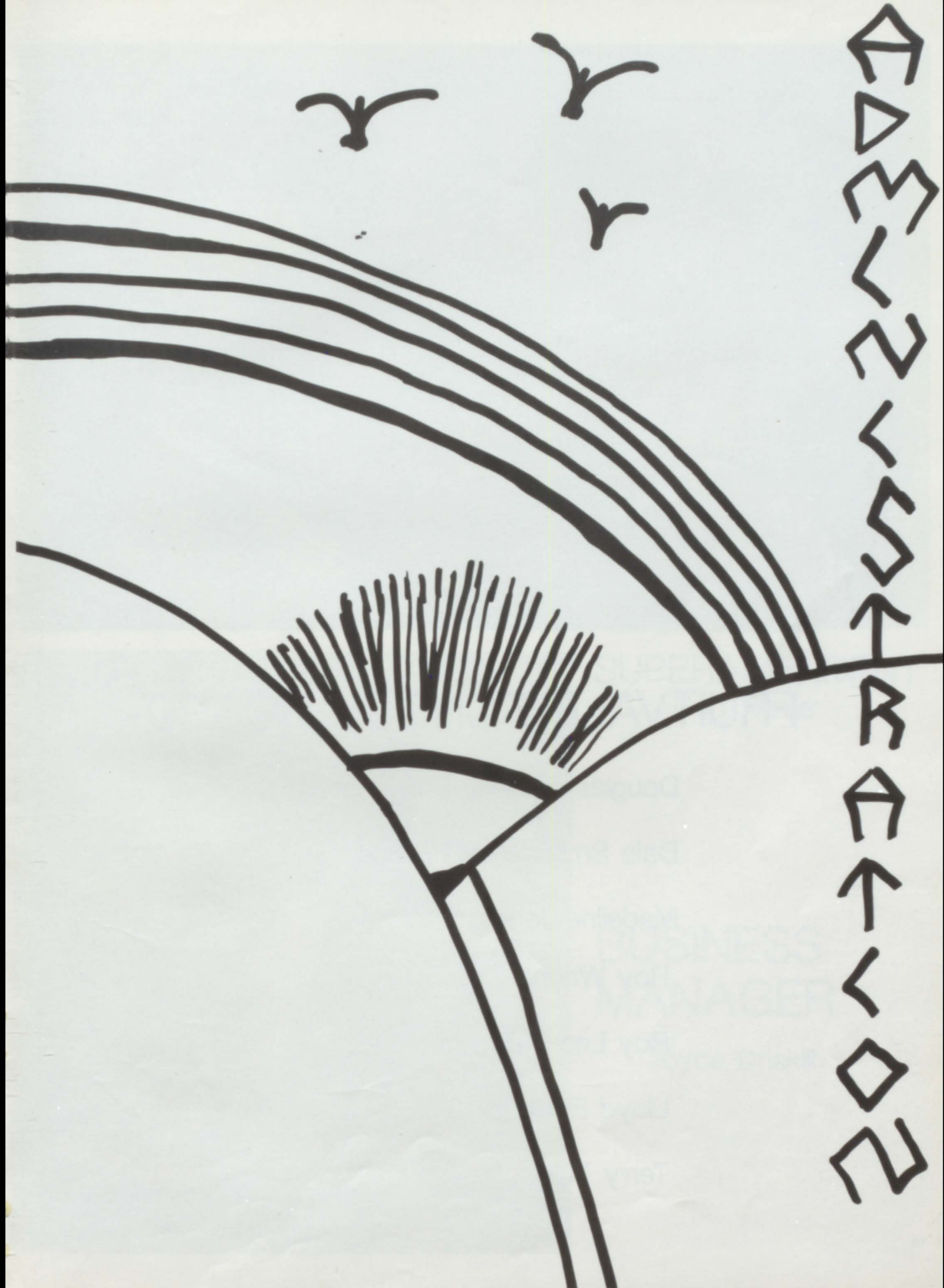
