A. Clark called the meeting to order. The September 12, 2018 meeting minutes were presented. Mrs. Bain made a motion to approve last month's minutes, and D. Erwin seconded. Mrs. Bain appointed A. Clark as chairperson of DIT. A. Clark stated that a secretary/notetaker was needed. K. Thompson volunteered. Mrs. Bain made a motion to nominate K. Thompson, and the committee unanimously voted for her to serve as the secretary/notetaker for DIT during the 2018-2019 school year.

Officer Perkins gave a safety report. He said the the district's radio system has been working well. He also stated that all buildings without addresses on the outside will be getting them, and we will be getting new school zone signs.
