 FRUITVALE — The Fruitvale Independent School District voters overwhelmingly rejected a proposal to abolish the district by a margin of near 3-1, Elizabeth Everett, Van Zandt county clerk reported unofficial vote totals of 881 against to 169 for the proposal.
 In absentee voting, 34 voted against and 4 for abolition, Mrs. Everett said. The county clerk estimates overall turnout at 18 a.m. Monday to canvass and approve Saturday's vote.
 School officials were pleased with the result. "To me, this indicates that a clear majority of people want the school," Superintendent Don Travis said.
 Travis said Saturday's vote indicates there would have been most affected by the school effort — the students.
 "The vast majority are the kids because they definitely wanted the school," he said. "The study turned out as we thought — they said they were going to stay the school, and regardless of outcome — and there are a lot of happy kids here."
 Approximately 30 high school seniors signed notes in the election were among the 15 who registered just before the registration deadline. A large number of registrants and the high voter turnout — approximately 80 — were positive before the election as indications that the vote would be high.
