Please note, there are two days of performances, however, Fruitvale only performs on Friday afternoon.

- ❖ Admission is \$10.00 per day, per person, at the door for general admission. Spectators must abide by all UIL policies and guidelines regarding entry and exit at the contest. Masks shall be worn by all patrons at all times. Only actors during performance may remove their

masks. A simple COVID check will occur for both participating companies and patrons.

- ❖ The house will open 10 minutes prior to the start of each play. A maximum of 406 tickets will be sold each contest day. Tickets will not carry over from one day to the next.
- ❖ *****Companies will be allowed 50% capacity for spectators (403 people) for each school's show - maximum.** These guests will be seated only during the time between the shows. We highly encourage you to be on time for any plays you watch but if you arrive after a play has begun, we will make a reasonable attempt to seat any late arrivals near the top of the house, as we know parents and supporters make every effort to drive out and watch their students.
- ❖ While you may watch shows from other schools, we highly encourage you to consider the audience another school may have travelling to support them. Please be respectful and aware of the limitations we are under to ensure all parents and supporters get to see 'their' show at the PAC.
- ❖ Food and drink of any kind will not be permitted due to COVID-19.
- ❖ In order to maintain the proper atmosphere for enjoying a live theatre performance, no videos, flash photography or otherwise, may be taken during the performances.
- ❖ The audience should also not bring infants or very young children who are likely to disturb the performances.
- ❖ The PAC seating will be cleaned between audience groups while the next show is setting up on the stage.
- ❖ Waxahachie ISD will post health and safety expectations for participating schools prominently at designated contest entrances. Hand sanitizing stations will be established outside of rehearsal and performance areas for all participants.
- ❖ Students should be released outside of the PAC facility, only to their director, or parent/guardian, outside of the facility after the performance/event. No audience members will be allowed to gather in the foyer of the PAC space indoors - all performers and spectators will exit the space at the conclusion of each performance for cleaning.
- ❖ Students will utilize face coverings throughout their time in the indoor space and should remain covered until clear of the space and outdoors/free of large groups.

- ❖ Waxahachie ISD Health and Safety staff will be on call as needed to examine all contest areas for compliance of social distancing and mask use.

(These admission allowances are pending WISD COVID status at the time of the contest and may change at any time.)**
