Referral Form for Gifted/Talented Program

From the Texas State Plan for the Education of Gifted/Talented Students (April 2019):

"§29.121. Definition. In this subchapter, "gifted and talented students" means a child or youth who performs at or shows the potential for performing at a remarkably high level of accomplishment when compared to others of the same age, experience, or environment and who: (1) exhibits high performance capability in an intellectual, creative, or artistic area; (2) possesses an unusual capacity for leadership; or (3) excels in a specific academic field. "

To refer a student for the Fruitvale ISD Gifted and Talented Program, please complete this form and return it to the student's campus or teacher.

Assessment information will be obtained for each referred student through quantitative and qualitative measures, including:

- State Assessment (when available)
- District Academic Assessments
- Abilities test results
- Teacher evaluation
- Parent evaluation
- Student Portfolio, such as work samples and additional progress data.

The district G/T Referral Committee will review the assessment information and will determine the need for placement in the G/T program, based on guidelines established by the district.
