

SAFETY FIRST!

Never look at the Sun without ISO or CE-rated eclipse solar glasses, sunglasses are not safe for looking at the sun. During the 4 minutes of totality, this is optional, but it is better to be safe.

Wear Sunscreen! If you are staying out for long periods of time.

What to Expect:

- Population Influx

- •Food (possible shortages)
- •Fuel (possible shortages)
- •Lodging (Hotels, RV Parks, Camping, State Parks, Bubba's pasture, Airbnb, VRBO)

- ·Cellular, Wi-Fi, 911)
